Lots of new parents are stepping up to help coach our future Panthers.

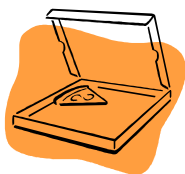
Our Panther registered kids continue to improve their skills which is great to see. Our Grade 2's will soon be playing at Sandringham, which is always a good day.

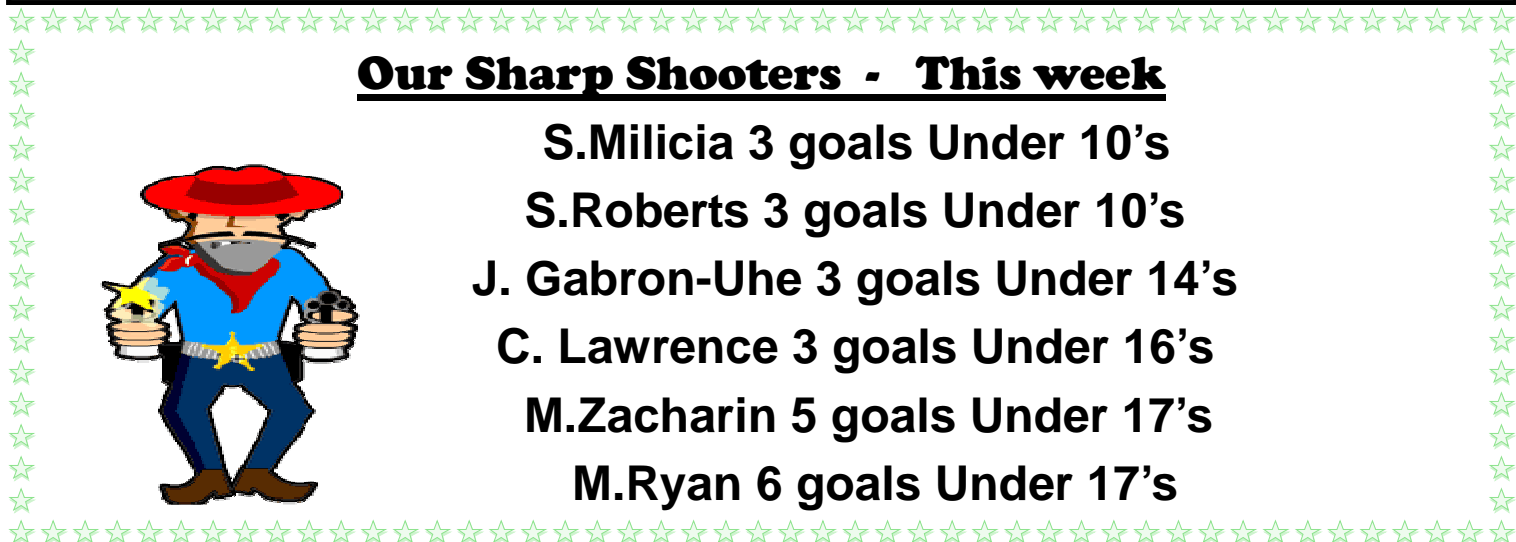
